3. The City of Conway Recreation Center will host a learning academy and luncheon with Paralympian Jill Moore on July 24, 2019 from 12:00 pm to 1:30 pm. Moore will give a presentation on the importance of inclusive play for youth. This presentation comes after the City's desire to build a new, inclusive playground for its residents. 4. As part of the Comprehensive Plan process concerning residential design standards, the City is conducting a visual preference survey to determine the design features that City residents want to see in new neighborhoods. You can find information on that survey [here](#).
5. The City is also conducting a public survey to inform the Comprehensive Plan. This survey comes before public meetings to discuss the Future Land Use Map. You can find information on those meetings and the survey [here](#).
6. City of Conway crew members removed all of the playground equipment from both Riverfront Park and Sherwood Forrest Park this week. The equipment was flooded during Hurricane Florence, and now that FEMA funds have been approved, the City can now begin the RFP process to install new playground equipment in those areas. The plan is to find equipment with material that will not be damaged by flood waters in any future storm.

7. Thanks to DHEC, the City of Conway will be able to expand its recycling program with 500 free recycling carts for residents. In 2018, the City of Conway, thanks to grant funding from DHEC and the Horry County Solid Waste Authority, purchased 1,200 recycling carts to offer residents on a first-come, first-served basis. The response to the program was overwhelming, and the City is now seeing it pay off, as we have diverted more than 85 tons of recyclable materials from going to the landfill.
