The committee discussed the current progress of installation, the second phase design, and the naming of the park. - 6. Great news! We have 500 more recycling carts to give away as part of another grant from SCDHEC and Horry County Solid Waste! The City has already handed out 1,200 free recycling carts and increased our recycling by 10-14 TONS per month! That's huge because the grants not only save the environment, but they also save taxpayer dollars. We pay NO fees to drop recycling at the landfill. The Conway Police Department will participate in "Operation Clear Track" railroad safety detail on Tuesday, September 24th to mark Rail Safety Week at the 5-points intersection near Sherwood Park. "Operation Clear Track" is a safety initiative hosted by Amtrak Police and Operation Lifesaver Inc. to bring police and sheriff's departments together to enforce state grade crossing and trespassing laws on America's railroad tracks. Operation Lifesaver is a non-profit organization dedicated to the reduction of railroad-related deaths and injuries across the U.S. and Canada.
