Notice is hereby given that a Nonpartisan Run-off Election will be held in the City of Conway, South Carolina, on Tuesday, November 19, 2019, to elect City Council members.

Voting hours will be from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 19th, at the following precinct locations:

<u>Coastal Carolina</u>—Christ the Servant Lutheran Church; <u>East Conway</u>—Conway Library; <u>Four Mile</u>—Bethany Bible Chapel; <u>Homewood</u>—Homewood Elementary School; <u>Jamestown</u>—South Conway Elementary School; <u>Maple</u>—Maple Baptist Church; <u>North</u> <u>Conway #1</u>—Mary Thompson Building at Collins Park; <u>North Conway #2</u>—Conway Elementary School; <u>Racepath #1</u>—Conway Senior Center; <u>Racepath #2</u>—Whittemore Park Middle School; <u>Red Hill #1</u>—Christ the Servant Lutheran Church; <u>West Conway</u>—Horry County Government & Justice Center; <u>Wild Wing</u>—Christ the Servant Lutheran Church.

At the close of the election, tallying of results will be held in City Council Chambers, 229 Main Street, Conway.

Registered electors who cannot vote in person may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot. Voters who would like more information about absentee voting should contact the Horry County Voters Registration Office located at 1515 4th Avenue, Conway.

The absentee ballots will be opened and examined in the Elections office at 9 a.m. on Tuesday, November 19th.

CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION

The Municipal Election Commission will hold a hearing on Thursday, November 21, 2019, at 2:00 p.m. for the purpose of determining the validity of all provisional ballots and certifying the election results. The certification will be held in the conference room at Conway City Hall, 229 Main Street, Conway.
