
CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Blain-Bellamy called the meeting to order.

CONSTRUCTION OF BARRIERS ON US HIGHWAY 501. Earlier this afternoon State Transportation Secretary Hall and Deputy Secretary for Engineering Leland Colvin met with Council members on the barrier construction site on US Highway 501. Secretary Hall and Deputy Secretary Colvin went over information that was shared earlier today in their meeting with Mayor Blain-Bellamy and others. Following this visit to the construction site, City Council reconvened its meeting at the Public Safety Building at 6:40 pm and discussed its earlier action relative to seeking an injunction in this matter. **Motion:** Goldfinch made a motion, seconded by Hubbard, to rescind its action authorizing staff to seek an injunction to halt construction of the floodwater barriers on US Highway 501 Bypass in the City limits. **Vote:** Unanimous. Motion carried.

CONSIDERATION OF EMERGENCY CURFEW: The curfew in the City of Conway is currently being imposed from 7 pm to 7 am. Mayor Blain-Bellamy, with Council's agreement, adjusted curfew hours to 10 pm to 6 am. The curfew remains in effect until lifted by the Mayor.

ADJOURNMENT: **Motion:** Goldfinch made a motion, seconded by White, to adjourn the meeting. **Vote:** Unanimous. Motion carried.
