Inclusive Playground Equipment for the City of Conway

The following are the questions that were received about the Inclusive Playground Project:

Can you give us a preferred length of the protective netting?

- The length of the protective netting will be completely dependent on the footprint of the playground you propose. We want to make sure it will adequately provide the necessary safety for playground.
- Can the site be moved back towards centerfield? Closer to the picnic shelter. This allows access to the site as well as the existing parking lot.
 - Closer to Centerfield is acceptable provided you will be meeting all the other requirements of the RFP.
- Site issues regarding the drainage swell pushing water towards current desired location.
 - We will be meeting tomorrow afternoon (Monday 15th) with our Streets and Water departments to go over all the changes that will need to be made to the site, part of this will include this issue.
- Are there any wind load issues that we need to be aware of? For the shade in particular?
 - All structures should meet the existing building codes for the City of Conway, in addition to this, all shade structures should be able to be storm prepped (shade sails need to be removable by our staff).
- Will the City of Conway be covering the project/cost to install sidewalks from the parking and public access areas up to the playground area which contains the turf surfacing?
 - Yes, the City of Conway will handle sidewalks leading to the project area, however, the winning bidder should work closely with the City to assure that the transition area from sidewalk to turf is accessible.
- Will the City of Conway complete/cover costs for a sidewalk or concrete ribbon boarder around the turf surfacing of the playground or does the vendor need to include in the bid an applicable boarder (excluding sidewalk & concrete ribbon boarder) around the playground area with the turf surfacing?
 - The bidder should include the concrete ribbon boarder in the bid.
- Will the City of Conway be completing the excavation and leveling of the existing site?
 - The City plans to rough grade the site, the extent of this work will be limited.
- Can the City of Conway GIS provide a CAD drawing of the existing drain areas so we know what is underground and where to tie into as this can affect the cost to connect into underground lines. Can the City of Conway also provide in this the electrical wiring underground for the baseball fields.
 - We will be working on this tomorrow (Monday 15th) and will get you all drawings that are relevant as soon as possible.
