Mayor Blain-Bellamy called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. Graham confirmed media outlets had been notified of this meeting. The meeting was conducted in an informal setting which allowed for a very informative discussion among City Council and staff.

The purpose of this emergency meeting was to report on damages and the City's recovery efforts in the aftermath of Hurricane Matthew. Graham gave general comments about the City's recovery efforts followed by more detailed reports by staff and Le Hendrick, the City's Fire Chief and Disaster Preparedness Manager. As the reports were being made, City Council asked questions about details of concern. At the conclusion of the meeting, Mayor Blain-Bellamy, along with all of City Council, expressed appreciation to staff for their efforts toward recovery after the storm.
