PUBLIC UTILITIES DEPARTMENT UTILITY TRADESWORKER I

The City of Conway is seeking a qualified candidate for the position of Utility Tradesworker I. This position performs semiskilled and skilled work in the installation, repair and maintenance of water and sewer lines and appurtenances; does related work as required. Work is performed under the regular supervision of a Utility Operations Crew Leader.

Responsibilities include install, maintain and repair water and sewer lines and appurtenances; make water and sewer taps and service connections; install and replace meters; operate trucks, air hammer and other mechanical equipment; operate confined space and other safety equipment in performance of related duties; install water meters, fire hydrants and valves; raise valve boxes; perform general ground maintenance tasks; excavate and backfill trenches; perform landscaping on property after work is completed; perform various maintenance tasks of city buildings including carpentry, electrical and plumbing repairs; clean vehicles and equipment after use; may be required to work after hours on an on-call basis; performs related tasks as required.

<u>Minimum Experience and Training</u>: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from high school and some construction and maintenance experience of 1 to 2 years.

Special Requirements:

Possession of a Class B CDL valid in the State of South Carolina.

Must obtain an Asbestos Cement Certification within twelve (12) months of employment and a Class D Water Distribution System Certificate within twenty-four (24) months of employment.

Entry level pay for this position is \$28,426.00 (\$13.67 per hour)
