2. Can you clarify on the bid proposal form page you have "material" and "labor" line and then "labor" again. Is the labor on the first line intended to be the deliver cost and the second "labor" would represent the installation and anything related to the installation ( such as installation templates etc ) **That is correct. The first lines are for the material and labor costs associated with the creation of the signage. The second is for the optional installation bid labor bid, as materials should be included in the former bid location.**
3. Which 27 sign's in the message schedule are the pedestrian signs vs the vehicular signs? **The RFP errantly left out the link to the location of the mapping of the wayfinding signage. The maps can be found at [www.cityofconway.com](http://www.cityofconway.com) with the RFP and Addenda. The downtown map notes the location of the 27 pedestrian level signs. The remainder of the signs are shown in the full map (which also shows downtown)**
4. If we submit with the 5%, if we are not accepted for the bid will the money be refunded? **Yes, if your bid is not accepted or awarded, the 5% will be refunded.**
5. I was wondering if you could provide me with a copy of the specifications, because the copy I have has no attached spreadsheet that states the locations and directional arrows.
