RECYCLING INFORMATION

Recycling conserves costly landfill space and protects our environment.

<u><i>What to recycle</i></u>	<u><i>How to recycle</i></u>
Aluminum beer and soft drink cans; aluminum foil and pie plates.	Empty cans and clean or rinse foil and pie plates. Place in bin.
All plastic food or drink containers, bleach, and detergent bottles, other household cleaner bottles, and shampoo bottles, etc.	Remove caps, rinse and flatten bottles, and place in bin. Labels don't need to be removed.
All glass food and beverage containers.	Rinse bottles and jars. Place in the bottom of bin. Labels don't need to be removed.
Vegetable or fruit cans, any steel can or aerosol can.	Rinse can and place in the recycling bin. Place lids inside the cans.
All corrugated cardboard, pasteboard,	Flatten empty boxes and place in the recycling bin.
Newspaper, phone books, inserts, magazines, other soft covered books and junk mail.	Place newspapers and magazines against the wall of the bin so the wind cannot blow them away.
Office and computer paper	Place paper inside the recycling bin at the bottom if possible so that the wind will not blow it away.

Collection

Rollout garbage carts and recycle bins are to be placed at the curb by 7 a.m. on the day of collection and removed from the curb by 7 p.m. on the day of collection. **To order a new roll out cart or recycle bins, call 248-1780 for cost information and delivery.**

Yard Debris

Most yard debris is picked up on normal collection day; however, during peak leaf season, please allow up to 48 hours from day of collection for pick-up. Yard debris must be placed at the curb by 7 am on your normal collection day. Limbs should not exceed 4 feet in length. **The City does not pickup trees, logs, or stumps resulting from the removal of trees. Such debris must be removed by residents or contractors providing the service.**

Bulk / Heavy Items

Place washing machines, clothes dryers, bedding material, furniture and clothes items (bagged) by the curb by 7 am on your normal collection day. This service applies to residential customers only and does not include building materials, roofing, rocks, concrete, tires, etc...

Commercial Cardboard Recycling

Cardboard recycling is also available to all commercial customers.
