

# Political Sign Regulations

The City of Conway has a Zoning Ordinance that addresses the posting of political signs within the City limits of Conway.

The City asks that all political offices comply with our ordinances. The City will remove all illegal signs.

Signs that are removed by the City will be disposed of by the City. The City does not have any means of storing or tracking the collection of signs.

The actual ordinance is located in the Conway Zoning Ordinance, Article 12, Section 12.1040 (G) and reads as follows:

## Temporary Political Signs

Temporary political signs announcing political candidates seeking public office, political parties, and/or political and public issues contained on a ballot shall be subject to the following requirements:

### Sign Area:

#### Commercial Districts:

In commercial districts the number of temporary political signs per zoning lot shall be one (1) sign per candidate or issue. Such signs shall not exceed four (4) square feet in gross surface area for each exposed face nor exceed an aggregate gross surface area of eight (8) square feet.

### Location:

Temporary political signs may be located in any yard or required yard, but **shall not be located in any public right-of-ways.** Such signs shall not be located in any required site triangle as set forth in Section 11.1065.

### Height:

Temporary political signs shall not project higher than ten (10) feet as measured from average grade of lot.

### Timing:

Temporary political signs may be erected or maintained for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days prior to the date of the election to which such signs are applicable and shall be removed within seven (7) days following such election.
